EASTERN CAPE-BASED COMMUNITY RADIO STATION TO RECEIVE GOVERNANCE TRAINING.

The National Electronic Media Institute of South Africa (NEMISA) has partnered with the Media Development Diversity Agency to provide capacity-building training on governance for board members of Eastern Cape-based community radio stations.

Arising from the “Future Proofing Community Radio” workshops, the general need expressed was for Governance Training. Subsequent to the “Future Proofing” Conferences, NEMISA developed a 5iQ Governance Toolkit for station management and board members.

An estimated number of 51 attendees from several radio stations in the province will learn the basics of effective governance, including board strategies and structures, codes of conduct, ethical practices, and statutory requirements that will ensure that you are equipped with the right tools of the trade to serve your community better.

This two-day (2) workshop is instructor-led by Dr. Harlan Cloete, currently the Chairperson at Radio KC, Paarl, and a research fellow at the University of the Free State. His main research interest is exploring evidence-based HRD governance systems in the public sector with a keen interest in local government.
